Silent Voice begins with a flashback way back in elementary school, an insensitive thrill-seeking Shōya Ishida bullying a meek and deaf Shōko Nishimura. Flanked by his pair of male childhood besties, the anime gives audiences a concrete illustration of Shōya's escalating campaign of harassment:

"screaming loudly into her ears; aping her tonedeaf nasally speaking; saying nasty things about her behind her back; writing nasty things about her on the blackboard; scribbling nasty things about her on her desk; stealing her school materials; ditching her school materials; stealing her expensive hearing aids; destroying her expensive hearing aids; making her ears bleed while ripping them off her ears; getting into a full-on scrap" All the while, the rest of her classmates grew distant from her, annoyed by the accommodations they're asked to make for her special needs, afraid of being targeted for being seen as too close. A few even join Shōya and pals in some of the lighter harassment.

Missing in this flashback and my description of these elementary school days are the adults. Well ... more literally in my description and less literally in the flashback. A music teacher does make a brief appearance, a homeroom teacher with more frequency. More precisely, what's actually absent here is responsibility, the responsibilities we expect adults to model for kids: parents and teachers especially. At the end of the day, school is more than just making kids absorb academic information. Much of that information ends up not being relevant and useful to most anyway, later discarded and forgotten. More than teaching kids math and science, school is



also a socialization agent; it teaches kids how to live and get along with others in society.

The adults at school who fail to guide the kids they're in charge of set those kids up for terrible failure as they grow up. Bullying between kids goes on in *A Silent Voice* in part because the responsible adults fail to notice or care enough to step in properly. The bullied develop debilitating social anxieties and crushing self-esteem issues. The bullies grow up with warped personalities and thought processes. The bystanders learn to be cowardly or callous, in huge part because of the homeroom teacher's example. While this homeroom teacher maintains a significant role at the beginning of the movie, important scenes of his in the original manga story unfortunately didn't make the film cut. His presence is that important to the themes of *A Silent Voice* that his actions and attitude in the anime and manga still bear addressing, regardless.

Now, at the moment of this writing, I'm also a teacher, and to a lesser degree, I'm afraid that fiction is being reproduced in reality with several, insensitive, thrill-seeking boys.

For those who don't know, more likely because they don't follow me on Twitter, I work in Japan as an ALT, or Assistant Language Teacher. I'm an assistant English teacher basically, and it's my job to help the Japanese instructor in charge to teach English well. I work in junior high schools, and I work in elementary schools. I have troublesome classes and students at both the secondary and primary levels of education, but for here, I will be narrowing my focus in this write-up to my primary school, elementary school experience. I have troublesome elementary school boys, and colleagues who are amiss at what to do. They aren't so bad individually, but they are absolutely nightmarish once you put them together in the same room. Unfortunately, they're classmates. Outside of class, they like to grapple and hit each other. Inside of class, they like to hit and grapple with each other. In addition to constant rough housing, they will not sit still during class. They will constantly talk over and occasionally, deliberately, disrupt their teachers and the lesson. Why do they do this? As far as I can tell, sheer boredom.

In A Silent Voice, elementary schooler Shōya monologues: it's his sworn duty, every day, to defeat his boredom in battle. He's especially fond of jumping off a local bridge into the relatively shallow creek below, a rush not unlike the kind some people get from skydiving. It's forbidden and reckless action to many, but to him, it's an absolute thrill and delight. He can't jump off bridges all the time because he as school, but a surreptitious development seemingly saves his war: a deaf girl transfers into his school. To Shōya, his deaf new classmate Shōko is something different, novel and exotic to poke at for an amusing reaction. She's especially fun because, like the snails he's salted and the ants he's stepped on, she hardly ever retaliates back. It's like she's giving him permission to bully her, even as she (and probably the snails and ants) want the exact opposite. Other classmates put distance between them and Shōko because they're irritated by her or want no trouble. Other classmates join in Shōya's bullying because it looks fun





or they want to fit in. The homeroom teacher does pitifully little about it until his hand is forced.

In an ideal world, I guess, people who get start getting bullied should speak up for themselves and fight back. Not all people are built like that though: not all adults and especially not kids. Kids are still figuring out how they need to act among others, and schools exist in part to train students for that end. In an ideal world, unequivocally, adults would not only lecture students on how they should behave. They'd also intervene, correct and discourage future misbehavior. Sometimes before kids learn to abstain from drawing on the walls, adults and usually parents catch them in the act first. They communicate to them that they need to stop and never do it again — for some, just once, and for others, repeatedly.

That negative reinforcement can range from being scolded and shouted at to having enjoyable privileges taken away and withheld. It's important though for parents and teachers to communicate clearly why a certain behavior is bad and not good. Failing to do so may otherwise give kids warped ideas about what's right and wrong later in life. For example, I barked initially at my troublesome Japanese elementary students to sit down, stay on task and stop fighting each other. I'm not in the best position to explain why, given my limited Japanese language abilities, but I did what I thought was right.

Anyway, word later got back to me about why I had to be so harsh with them when their homeroom teacher wasn't. They were receiving mixed messages, and I was eventually told it wasn't my responsibility to enforce discipline on students. It was the homeroom teacher's to discipline their class, and I was out of line and inviting trouble for myself. The moral they probably got from this story was that it's perfectly fine for them to misbehave so long as they could get away with it. They certainly are for now, but I can't help but a continuing lack of self-control will harbor for their futures. Society gives kids the space to bruise themselves and learn from their mistakes, but when they become adults? As mentioned before in my ReLIFE article, the consequences can be far more severe and damaging to the individual and the rest of society. The individual will get shit for it and the others around them also get sullied.

The homeroom teacher I work with happens to be person that's gentle soft-spoken in nature. And to clarify, there isn't any bullying going on as far as I or anyone else can see to mark an intervention as urgent. The homeroom teacher in *A Silent Voice* is someone who can make himself sternly and angrily heard without trouble.

Shōya's homeroom teacher can see that there's evident teasing, harassing, bullying toward someone who doesn't wish it going on. The guy takes him aside now and again to tell him to knock it off, though not in a way that rings of seriousness or sincerity. Shōya asks why, and he brings up the abstract concept of "morals" that the boy then replies he doesn't understand. So instead of explaining what "morals" are in a concrete way he can understand, he shows how unfit and dangerous he is as both homeroom teacher and public servant. He first complains about how much Shōya's parents and guardians failed at teaching him "morals" before concluding it's one of those things he has to follow, leaving Shōya confused and unchanged. He later undermines his music teaching colleague's attempt promote sign language learning to the class as a better connect with Shōko, claiming it's unfair to make everyone who doesn't want to.

The truth behind his objection becomes clear when he admits that he doesn't personally object to what Shōya's doing, giving him mixed messages. He doesn't explain to him what "morals" he mentioned earlier means because he either doesn't fully understand them himself or he doesn't really agree with them. "Morals" are only relevant to him insofar as he must



follow them enough to keep his job. Even with this admission though, he's half-assed in his indulgence of it to Shōya, since that's not something he should be clearly admitting because of society's "morals." So the homeroom teacher closes his final talk with Shōya before he gets busted up for bullying by telling him not to embarrass him. The message obviously doesn't register with Shōya, and he continues doing what he likes.

It also just so happens the one who does eventually bust Shōya up for his bullying is this same homeroom teacher, and no one else. He doesn't care about the bullying since it's not his personal problem if it's manageable, or he believes it's too



much trouble to care about personally until it blows up. And when it does blows up, when his superiors catch on to the class's problem and makes his personal problem, when he's presumably told to get to the bottom of it all and find the culprit quickly, he chooses ... him. He immediately and unhesitatingly fingers Shōya, and only Shōya, the most prominent bully, without any prompting from his other students. If there was any prompting involved, it was him encouraging his students to lie, just like him, about their complicity in the bullying.

Teacher and students lie about their complicity in the bullying, making Shōya the sole fall guy and letting everyone else save face. By implicating just him and not anyone else in Shōko's bullying, the homeroom teacher especially saves his crooked half-ass. It's bad enough that one of his students was seen as a bully, but if multiple students were also identified as being complicit, what does that say to parents, his superiors, and society-at-large as someone in charge of kids? That he was so negligent or incompetent at his job that he didn't notice so many of his kids breaking bad? Since he manages a large class size, he could maybe get away with one of his kids being awful to his superiors because he could only pay attention to one student for so long before attending to others. The homeroom teacher skates by without injury to his employ-

ment, but what moral did this entire situation impart to his kids, ultimately?

Apparently, that it's okay not take responsibility for your actions so long as there's someone else to blame. Miki Kawai grows up completely blacking out her own parts in fueling the escalating drama of Shoko's bullying, following the homeroom teacher's lead and defaulting blame to Shōya and just him. Naoka Ueno grows up blaming Shōko for ruining hers and Shōya's happy elementary school life, despite being the second person to throw Shōya under the figurative moving bus (the homeroom teacher was the first). When kids are still kids, they observe what adults do and copy their behavior. Within the walls of a school classroom, where kids learn how to act in society when they are adults, teachers are not only supposed to lecture about morals. They are also supposed to model them. When the teacher and most significant adult in the classroom is a dishonest, selfish, responsibilitydodging asshole

... should we really wonder that the children that are supposed to learn from him mimic his dishonest, selfish, narcissistic-asshole behavior? Even if parents and guardians do lapse to teach their children morals, that is no excuse for teachers to abdicate their own moral responsibility. Both parents and teachers are expected by society to act as socializing agents, because society would otherwise be overrun and rendered dysfunctional by assholes.

What are these "morals" that society wants to promote, and why do they matter? A society is a collection of people that are bound together by social contract. This social contract allows people to reside and cooperate with each other to achieve endeavors they would otherwise be unable to do by themselves, such as living in peace without want. Predatory, bullying, and asshole behavior by enough people, enough actors, undermines the social contract and threatens society itself. It's entirely possible to understand the social contract in terms of transaction, which is how Shōya's homeroom teacher interprets his place as a member of society. He follows the rules at their minimum so as to not be overly recognized and penalized by society-at-large as a bad actor. It makes what he's doing in his teaching position especially insidious if not fully intentional, training the next generation's members of society to be bad actors.

The best defense of the social contract are people who are taught to be sensitive and considerate: actors who are empathetic. Nowhere in the homeroom teacher's half-assed attempts at making Shoya wise up does he ever ask him to imagine how he'd feel if he was in her shoes, if he was being bullied. And Shōya does wise up. He does feel regret and guilt what he's done to Shōko, but only after the tables get turned and he became a victim of bullying by Ueno, Kawai, his former male besties, and the rest of the class. It is through the traumatically unambiguous communication of experience does he realize that bullying is wrong, that his struggle with boredom is not worth someone's pain. All this suffering on Shōya and even Shōko may have been avoided though, if the homeroom teacher tried explained to Shōya how "morals" mean empathy and why empathy is important. The homeroom teacher doesn't value empathy though. He's an asshole, and what's worse, he's an adult.

Adults should know better. But Shōya's still a kid. He still

has space to learn, and he has.

The adults at school who fail to guide the kids they're in charge of set those kids up for terrible failure as they grow up. Bullying between kids goes on in A Silent Voice in part because the responsible adults fail to notice or care enough to step in properly. The bullied develop debilitating social anxieties and crushing self-esteem issues. Shoko Nishimura and later Shōya Ishida remain victims of these feelings of inadequacy and guilt even up to high school. The bullies grow up with warped personalities and thought processes. Miki Kawai and Naoka Ueno especially with complexes that absolve them from any wrongdoing way back when. The bystanders learn to be cowardly or callous, perhaps like me with my troublesome kids. These are the lessons they initially draw from their childhood: that others are cruel, that they should be cruel like others, or both. They learn these lessons because the adults that are supposed to guide them are either absent or cruel, too.

I am not in a great position to help my misbehaving Japanese students. I can't speak Japanese well enough to communicate to them why they need to stop. I don't have the authority or the presence in their lives that the homeroom teacher possesses. The music teacher that they don't see every day couldn't reach Shōya's class about being more empathetic Shōko because she was undermined by the homeroom teacher. I, the ALT that my kids don't see every day, can't reach my boys with my seriousness and sternness because the homeroom teacher is a gentle and soft-spoken person by nature. At least they aren't bullies yet, I think. But, given the right circumstances, they may. The biggest thing in their lives right now is their seemingly dire and urgently selfimportant battle against boredom. As they move from one education level to the next, I hope someone better equipped than I can teach them to be... better. *** ZeroReqO11**

90's. The best animated shows were on Saturday mornings. The television was king and America's youth was their ever-faithful followers because it was either that or mowing the front yard. Week after week, it was this magic hour, dedicated

just for us, that we found a reason to getting out of bed and sit still for hours. So it was inevitable that some of our first experiences with a booming, overseas entertainment industry would take place at this time. When it happened, it was a shock to the senses. From the moment that "Rock The Dragon" started to play on the screen, I was captivated. I didn't even remember the name of the show by the time I was already engrossed in an adrenalin charged battle with characters screaming with unhinged fury, veins bulging out of foreheads and beatdowns that were the epitome of OVERKILL. And I couldn't get enough of it! I never knew how much I loved speed lines until that day. So, after that first episode, I was back for more a week later. "Japanimation?!" The name was so new. Anime wasn't yet popularized yet. Once I talked to schoolmates about it, I

encountered people that not only liked it, they suggested other shows that I couldn't even pronounce. First was Akira, then Ranma $\frac{1}{2}$, then Fishigi Yūgi... the list went on and on. Each suggestion was a new adventure into the world of Japanese animation. It felt like the next level of artistic expression. Even though there were new series being released a month, it was a fun challenge to keep up with it all. After all, there was only about two dozen series to follow at any give time. I could keep this up no problem.

20 years of life can really change your priorities in life. College, work and social life seemed to squeeze out many of my hobbies in those years. Fortunately, I connected with some people that shared the same interest in art as I did and I slowly began to reconnect with the industry. Just like myself, the industry had changed. It no longer belonged to the selected few, but instead was a completely different animal. Anime was popular! Really popular! The days of following a handful of series month for month were over. The advent of high streaming technology and more efficient publishing had turned this small exclusive hobby into an international juggernaut that cranks out hundreds of titles at mind-numbing speed. It didn't matter, I was back to being part of a community that shared my love of art. Question was; Was I ready to come back? Animé Los Angeles was a good start to find that answer.

"This is not what I was expecting." was the first thing I said to my editor as I waited in line for my badge. I arrived an hour before the convention even opened to make sure I got good parking and I donned a casual Saitama cosplay since I recently finished the first season of *One Punch Man.* The first thing I noticed was just how NORMAL I felt. With the badge line building, I noticed that I was one of many cosplayers. There was more cosplayers than not! The last time I cos-

played was at Anime Expo years before

and cosplay was for the brave and devoted. Wearing a half descent cosplay would make you feel like a celebrity with the gangs of cameras that would take your picture at any given time. Once again I was reminded how much time had changed things. Everyone was brave and everyone was devoted! Once I retrieved my badge, I walked into the halls of the Ontario Convention Center and was immediately faced with my first real crisis. "Where to?"

I confess, I don't handle crowds very well. Something about being moved like cattle through narrow pathways has never been my thing. ALA surprisingly wasn't like that at all. If things got dicey, there were plenty of places to retreat. From video rooms to photo studios to the various panels that litter the convention, there was plenty to experience. Not to say that AX didn't have these things, I just didn't feel like a sardine while experiencing them at ALA. They even had a quiet room! Fortunately, I too occupied it. As we made our way from one hall to another, I bombarded my colleague with the same question over and over.

"What's that from?!"

"Oh that's from... blah blah blah."

"Oh..." as I pretend to know what that blah even is. Spoiler alert; I didn't know. I didn't know that there was just so much out there and for

the first time since I reignited my interest in anime, I was left wondering, "Can I even come back to this hobby or has that train left me behind forever?" There was just so much of it. So many excellent cosplays. The unique thing that I noticed about this convention of others was how social the event was. People loved to ask questions. Loved to answer questions. They loved to just talk to you about anything! It is an extremely social gathering. I was not prepared for that, but I welcomed it. Despite age gaps and gender, it didn't matter. We were there for the same thing. The love of the art.

As the day flew by, my editor ushered me to one last panel that changed my whole outlook on the fandom. The panel, How to Outlive Your Otaku Expiration Date, struck at the very heart of all the doubts and anxieties I've been dealing with until that time. Almost as if the

panel knew that people like me were going to attend, it addressed who to handle the scale of anime industry had become and how to navigate the content to what applied to you. As I looked around the room, the attendees were not much different than myself. We were mostly middle aged and many of us didn't even have a clue where to start immersing ourselves back into world we temporarily left behind. There was a comfort in knowing that I wasn't the only one. There were many many people just like me! It left me leaving the convention with the knowledge that I can come back to what I love. That train isn't gone forever. **Solution**

An Interview with





hile attending Animé Los Angeles at the beginning of this year, I was graced with an interview with Kaho Shibuya-san. Since her retirement from the adult entertainment industry, she began her new career as a professional cosplayer. Kaho-san has appeared at cosplay-related events, appeared and been on television and radio shows. She she also been a guest for a few anime-related convention here in the United States, hoping to propel her cosplay career. She has aspirations to become a voice actress (seiyū) and is currently writing a book that should be out relatively soon. At the start of the interview, I had planned to ask preplanned questions. As the interview continued, it changed to become a casual, lighted-hearted conversation. We brought up a lot of references and its context will be in brackets. The following is the conversation we had ...

- Ed: So, yes, I do understand that you used to be a AV actress, but now you are moving into cosplay. Before that, I understand that you also to do "gravure." How is that ... if you don't mind me asking?
- Kaho-san: It's kind of a tough question. If you gonna ask me about ... I don't know... like nudity or...

Ed: Not that, but just like the ...

- Kaho-san: Difference between cosplay and regular gravure. The thing in gravure ... sometimes you kind of get used used to it, but then it's always the same thing you focus on ... how to accentuate your body. Especially for my case, my titties are here. How to make them look bigger ... nicer. You get used to ... like a triangle bikini or whatever. Maybe I try to get more skin and more skin. Sometimes you get ... you see enough you in the mirror. I just wanna ... I wanna a change of pace. I get bored of things, like so easily. I change jobs, like all the time. I like to try new things. So, I just get bored, like looking at my fave everyday... and doing the same make-up.
- **Ed:** The reason why I'm asking because the idea of gravure ... especially with modeling books ... that's very uncommon here.
- Kaho-san: Oh yeah, in the States. It's kinda like *Sports Illustrated,* but you don't have to be, like fit ... no, to do gravure. You can be a little bit chubby, like you know...

- Ed: Because last year... last spring, I was in Tōkyō. And I was looking at the some bookstores. I just happened to see the gravure books and, I mean I understand the concept of it, but you know, because there's so many in the bookstores compared to nothing here in our bookstores ... yeah.
- Kaho-san: But you guys still got some bathing suits, right?

Ed: But very rarely.

Kaho-san: Oh yeah! Oh, I didn't know that.

- **Ed:** Maybe is this was an entire section of the bookshelf... maybe something like this ... [showing space between my hands about 12 inches or so].
- Kaho-san: Only a few books ... magazines like *Playboy* or *Sport Illustrated* again. Ok. Oh, I see. And between Japan and here, like we got grave covers on, like regular manga magazines. *Jump, Shōnen Jump, Shōnen Sunday* magazine. Like old age magazine ... like comic books. So that's my view. Rare. So back to the cosplay and gravure thing. Like ... because I get to be bored looking at my face ... cosplay is a good thing for me so I get a different look each day. Even for this convention, I... on purpose chose different hair styles, different hair colors and eye colors for each day.
- **Ed:** Because, I cosplay too... but I don't think I do the eye color.
- Kaho-san: For day one, I did Jolyne from *Jo-Jo*. For day two, I did Mamako from ... [*Do You Love Your Mom and Her Two-Hit Multi-Target Attacks?*]
- Ed: Oh yeah, Mamako! Yeah, I actually read the light novels.
- Kaho-san: Oh yeah, you're a big fan. And day three, Android 18 from *Dragon Ball* and today, I'm Chi-Chi from *Dragon Ball*... so, like different looks. And that's so... that is so incredibly fun for me.
- **Ed:** Yesterday [Saturday] I was cosplaying Iwatani from *Shield Hero*.
- Kaho-san: Oh cool! I should've done Raphtalia with you. Anyway... and, cosplay again for... is for otakus, but you got shows from light novel or

manga ... anime ... where gravure is always for male demographics. It's always about like it being sexy. So like always point. So we got a bigger selection here, so I like that.

- **Ed:** Because I understand in Japan, there's only a certain body type that ... yeah, but that's not impor...
- Kaho-san: Some people like bigger boobs. Some people for go for loli or flat.
- **Ed:** Let's see... how did you ... well, how did you start getting into doing the cosplay modeling?
- Kaho-san: Me, I've always been otaku, myself. I've always been geek. During my... AV days, or when I was like ... a writer, I worked for a newspaper company. I just didn't have any time ... to focus on my hobbies because I was just too busy working. And it just stressed me out.

Ed: Oh, I know that feeling right now.

- Kaho-san: So, I just couldn't... I missed everything. I missed *K-On!* or I missed Love Life the first season. You know I missed... I even didn't recognize *Re:Zero* when it was on because I didn't I didn't have time to follow any anime. I was just too busy. And so...
- Ed: You know what? It's funny mention you mention *K-On!*, because *K-On!* is the show that actually made me start playing the guitar.
- **Kaho-san:** Oh my god, that's amazing! Yeah, but *K-On!*... But maybe I was just busy studying at college, or maybe ... or maybe I'm trying to hide my otakuness from others. I was in university in Shibuya and aware with other people are so like party-goers.

Ed: Because... besides Shibuya is a very fashionable... fashion district. [A ward west of cental Tōkyō, which there are 23.]

Kaho-san: I kinda have to hide my otakuness, just to... you know...

Ed: What are you talking about? [jokingly referring the other students]

Kaho-san: Haha. Right. So I guess ... I had to hide ... stay away from them for a little bit. So, now I finally know... get to ... just cherish who I am. Doing what I'm doing. And 24 hours because this kind ... my job is trash hobby so I'm loving it more and more.

Ed: How... when you mentioned that you were hiding your otakuness, I know that ... the people in Japanese see it differently than the people here.

Kaho-san: Yeah, negatively.

Ed: But... do you know why is that?

- Kaho-san: Now it's kind of getting more like otaku, you know... just like here in California. You know, like nerds. Just like ... maybe like American comic book nerds. Like big fancily nerd and people see you kinda negatively. And you're not good at communication. Like you just focus on things you like and you like to stay in. That's true to me too! But I guess when you're too passionate about certain things that people don't understand ... like, if others cannot share that passion with you, it's kinda hard to get along, I think. And especially in school ... if you're younger, it's always helps to share the same passion with something like sports.
- **Ed:** Yeah, even when I was in high school, there was very few of us what watch anime.
- **Kaho-san:** Nowadays, you can start writing light novels at young age, like 14 or 15. But at that time ...
- Ed: Or I understand even in Japan ... the mobile novels ...

Kaho-san: Yeah, and some kids starts creating manga, like doing *dōjin* and they sell very well. But, if you're too young in Japan, like you don't make money, it's not like it's your job... you're making making accomplishments by following manga or anime. Unlike sports. Like, maybe you get to win a sudden award or ... like you know, maybe you get to go awards tournament or something. You don't get any accomplishments ... maybe your parent frown upon that too. If you kinda casted away... that's why. [dōjin: Self-published manga, usually based on a show or a specific character of a show. Short for dōjinshi.]

Ed: Oh, just to let you know, I follow you on Twitter.

Kaho-san: Please follow me on Instagram too!

Ed: Ok. That ... I haven't done that yet.

Kaho-san: I post different photos.

Ed: You went to Comiket ... last at month. And ... I understand too you also attended other convention here in America. How do you feel the diffidence between the cosplayers in Japan ... between the cosplayers here. [Short for Comic Market: a bi-annual dōjinshi convention held in Odaiba, Tōkyō.]

Kaho-san: You cannot cosplay into the convention in Japan.

Ed: No!?

Kaho-san: You cannot wear cosplay outside, unless it's inside the convention. So they have, like, changing rooms for you. You have to change at the convention. That's I hate about it. I really hate ... here, you can just change into your hotel room and you can just walk from your hotel room. Or walk from your house. But in Japan, they too much about ... the peoples complaints. Like some people don't like ... seeing cosplays outside because it's not Halloween. So the convention people are ... don't want to receive those complaints. "Could you do that modestly only at the convention, not outside of the event?"

Ed: They have to respect the people around you.

- Kaho-san: Or like ... people in the city... who are not otaku. I understand that, you know. Some cosplayers are too obscene, you know. Yeah, but I guess here ... a lot more free. Not just that changing room thing, but also gender-free. A lot of female people wear male costumes.
- **Ed:** Actually, that's been a trend ... probably in the last five years.

Kaho-san: Like gender-swaps.

Ed: Yes, like gender-swaps. But, do they have any-thing like that there.

Kaho-san: In Japan, maybe you get criticized sometimes. You know... like you're very...

"parochial..." in a way. Like, you have to look the character or you have to be true to the original form. Like you know, don't try to arrange in your own way. Some people kinda hate that idea... which is kind of hypocritical because, like, dōjin groups. Because they made their own original way. Like you know, they made their own BL stories or yaoi stories out of regular shōnen manga. So, that's kinda weird, like we're kinda hypocritical about it. But, that's how Japanese people are sometimes. They're just too... how do I say... "majime." You the word "majime" that's kinda ... pig-headed or... You know we're not re... you know what I mean. We don't like big change. Like we're not ready yet. We have to start gradually. [BL: boys love... yaoi. Shōnen: young boy]

- **Ed:** Oh, slowly. Yeah. I think that normal in human nature that you can't change right away. It takes time.
- Kaho-san: Like everything is forward in the west ... like gay marriage and everything. We're not there

yet in a lot of sense.

- Ed: That leads me to the next question. I've noticed that... every now and then I see some photos of cosplayers in Comiket or something similar in Japan. And I see that maybe for one cosplayer... you have multiple... you have a lot of photographers around that.
- **Kaho-san:** Oh yeah! That's chaotic really. Some cosplayers cry, like because ... not all of them. Some photographers ... they like, really get close to you. Like as if they're just taking a picture of your pores, you know.

Ed: Wow!

Kaho-san: Your skin. They do like low angle thing to you know... to peek into the skirt.

Rimuru Tempest (Tensei Shitara Suraimu Dalta Ken)

- **Ed:** Is there anything to have them stop that. Like here, we have ... you've seen around the signs in the convention ... the Cosplay is Not Consent.
- Kaho-san: Yes! We try to send a message and ... especially because the age of internet ... Twitter... like sometime take a photo or video of those photographers ... annoying photographers. So, we try to criticize them. We try to stop them. Some people are nice enough to stop them so...
- **Ed:** Yeah, that's not being respectful to the cosplayer that maybe you might admire the ... cosplayer or the costume the cosplayer is wearing. That what they're doing is totally against that.
- **Kaho-san:** Definitely. There were a few cosplayers ... or just like regular women who are just wanting attentions for those guys. There was one girl who was ... on Twitter. She wasn't wearing cosplay. It's was just a another ... how do I say... like a fetishy cosplay. You know, like a schoolgirl uniform kind of thing. So it's not like a character cosplay. You can kind of see that she's an an otaku. She's just someone who is dressed in a nerdy attire to get attention of those photographers. So there are girls like that too ... just seeking attention.
- Ed: We have our good share here also. Wow.
- Kaho-san: You cannot always blame the photographers, but I guess we are more perverted. Because sex is kind of like a ... sex is kind in a paper bag in Japan. Here is more plastic bag, I guess. Like because we a lot of train restings ... resters on train. Because of the ... well, the train is kinda packed.
- Ed: Oh yeah. Believe me, I experienced the rush hour in Tōkyō.
- Kaho-san: I guess, like ... there are more molesters in Japan than in any other country because ... you see, our iPhones make a sound when you try to take a photo. But not in any other country. Not in Taiwan. Not in Korea. Nowhere in Asia or in western ... only our iPhones.
- Ed: Really? So... so even if you switch it to silent ...
- Kaho-san: Ah, no. You could use another app... Oh yeah, silent doesn't work.
- Ed: Oh wow! That's interesting. I never new that.
- **Kaho-san:** Because ... they can just start taking photos, like secretly. The inside of your skit or whatever...

- Ed: Oh, because I heard that ... I guess in rush the hour trains ... that is a special car at the ... one end just for women.
- Kaho-san: For women. For women only to save them form molesters. That's the fact you have to do that. It's says a lot about society.
- Ed: That tells you something ... yeah.
- Kaho-san: It's just one of our embarrassing culture, I guess.
- Ed: Ok ... wow. This really covered a lot of actually... what I wanted to talk about.
- Kaho-san: I want to say nice things about my country, of course. I grew up in Tōkyō, but, of course there always some issues ... problems that you have to acknowledge that.
- **Ed:** Of course. It's just like with any other country. Yeah.
- Kaho-san: Yeah, because I see not a lot of Americans like the President right now. So... it kinda like that. We don't like our Prime Minister, but there are some good things like he's done.



Tifa Lockhart (Final Fantasy VII)

- Ed: Yeah, actually we pretty much covered everything I wanted to talk about. Well, if ... is there anything you want to give advice to new cosplayers, you know... coming into... about beginning cosplaying.
- Kaho-san: Back to the culture thing ... I guess the reason why I chose ... you asked for, like my cosplay career. Like I ... I could ... I didn't go cosplay at Comiket actually. I just went there to get some goods. It was too cold and windy outside. Because of the photographer thing, you know. And because I guess Japan is more parochial the way of thinking. How do I say. Oh, I forgot the term. What's the adjective you describe for ... "per ..." Can I just Google the word?

Ed: Sure.

Kaho-san: I know the word in Japanese ... "conservative!" We're more conservative. That's the word I want! So the fact ... because my adult career in the past ... I think it's kinda hard ... harder for me to get into the regular life.

Ed: Mainstream ...

Kaho-san: Yeah, go mainstream in Japan and in here. Especially as cosplayer. The people expect me to just ... be sexy, you know. You're not a real cosplayer. Your just being sexy. You know, like a lude cosplayer. I've done, like radio ha ... radio shows ... like a regular radio shows in Japan. Or like TV shows but it's always ... I have to focus a little bit about my AV side. You know... to sell my personality. But I'm retired from that so I guess, kinda you know, draw some lines. It's very difficult. They always ...

Ed: They always try to bing it up again.

Kaho-san: Drill on it. So, that is which is why I'm

try to write a memoir of AV industry to become much more like a writer. Not the current actress.

Ed: Well, I mean because you worked in the newspaper before, you know, was that the line of work you were studying for in college?

Kaho-san: Oh yes.

Ed: Ok ... journalism?

Kaho-san: Journalism ... a little bit. So ... I can be more like a journalist if I finish doing the book. I'm actually... I have editor and I'm actually working on book. It isn't done yet. But, if the book is out, I can be more like an "EX"... actress. I am a ex-actress, but they don't treat me that way now because I'm still new. It's only been a year. So which is why, which is also why I'm more here than in Japan as cosplayer because people are more receptive here. You know, not drill upon my AV past. And even though like they're fans from AV, but they appreciate this. They don't judge be because of that. So that's why I like starting new things from here.

Ed: Yeah, to give yourself a fresh start? That's great. Well, I guess that's pretty much it then.

Kaho-san: Yeah, thank you. Thank you so much.

Ed: Thank yo very much. 💠







Ever Darkness & the Secret Hideout Game Review

Chelter Pyza

he story takes place on a small island called Kurken, in the town of Rasenboden. Reisalin Stout, or Ryza as she's commonly known, is the only daughter of a farming couple. Growing up in a small community, living an ordinary life, running errands, helping in the fields... Ryza hopes that something amazing happens. One day, Ryza decides to leave Kurken Island for the mainland in search of an epic adventure. With her friends Lent

Marslink, wanting to be a great warrior and explore the world, and Tao Mongarten, a soft-spoken intellectual wanting to learn more about the old Klint Empire, joins Ryza.

While exploring the Pixie Forest during their first time out, they come across Klaudia, saving her from a monster attack, but failed. Knocked out by the monster, they were saved by the town's patrol and brought back to Kurken. It turns out that she's the daughter of a





traveling merchant that just arrived in town. What was she doing in the forest? She was there to privately practice playing her flute. She later joins Ryza's group of adventures after persuading her father to let her.

Further exploration into the forest, Ryza and friends encounter a monster they've never seen before. Right before the monster's attack, it goes away unexpectedly. They soon encounter Empel Vollmer, an alchemist, and Lila Decyrus, his mysterious travel partner. They learn monsters from another universe are going to invade the mainland. Empel and Lila also join Ryza's group to investigate and stop the monster threat that could destroy their world. They got more that what they bargained for.

Gameplay

Atelier Ryza's gameplay is typical of any Japanese Role-Playing game (JRPG) played from a third-person perspective. It starts off with long cutscenes that sets the basis for the story and why they want to start their adventure. The gameplay is somewhat linear, similar

to Final Fantasy XIII. You progress through the game with a series story chapters. This basically tells the player what Ryza's group should do next. Upon completing the requirements or quests of a chapter, a new chapter appears to let them know what to do. Although you really can't progress unless a chapter is completed, you're still allowed to explore accessible areas of the world and gather materials for alchemy at any time.

During the course the of the game, there are quests that need to be completed in order to progress. Most of the quests are given out by the townspeople. Other major quests are given by nonplayers characters that have high positions in the town, by Empel or Lila. Upon completion of a quest, money, materials or a new recipe are rewarded.

Alchemy

Like Atelier Ryza's predecessors, the game's main focus is alchemy. At the beginning of the game, Ryza doesn't know any alchemy. She starts learning alchemy when her group encounters Empel and Lila at certain point in the storyline and given an alchemy cauldron.

Alchemy in *Atelier Ryza* works by gathering materials and learning recipes. Materials used in alchemy are things like plants, mineral ores, common foodstuff, oils, animal parts and so on. Tools that Ryza starts off with for gathering materials are the staff she carries around and by simply picking things up with her hands. As the game progresses, she learns to make better gathering tools such as a scythe, axe, hammer and fishing rod. These tools could be upgraded later in the game. Also, when she's traveling the world to gather materials, there's a limit to how much could be gathered. When the gathering basket is full, she could either drops some of the items to make room for more or go back to the atelier to store them in a holding container.

Creating items through alchemy is done by a sphere grid-like system. Each of the circular nodes represent a specific material needed in the recipe to create the item. By adding more materials to the node, traits, effects, roles, levels and so on are unlocked. Creating some items also lead to creating new items. There's a special "recipe" node in some recipes for this. When a required material is added to this node, a new item is created from the original recipe.

For example:

Uni + Gunpowder + Fuel = Explosive Uni. Uni + Gunpowder + Fuel + Red Suppliment = Craft (a stronger king of bomb)

Through the course of the game, Ryza acquires new

recipes by Empel teaching or giving her a book, characters giving her a recipe or buying recipe books. Also, tools, armor and weapons created by alchemy can be upgraded by reforging them up to Ryza's current alchemy level.

Mechanics

The combat system used in *Atelier Ryza* uses an active combat system rather the traditional turn-based system. Turns are based on the character's speed. There are also two modes of combat: normal and negative modes. In normal mode, your character take one regular action per turn. Negative mode allows character to perform special moves from the beginning. These modes can be turned off or on at any time during combat.

There's a combined pool of action points (AP) the party uses during combat. Special moves and performing magic uses up a predetermined number of action points. When action points are used up, the next character might not have enough action points to use especially moves. Action points are replenished by using regular action moves.

Another use for action points is to raise the tactics level during combat. If the AP gauge is filled up for that

When the tactics level is raised, more advanced and multiple combat moves could be done. Also, at the end of combat, additional experience points are given.

Conclusion As a JRPG fan that have been collecting the Atelier series games since the PlayStation 2, *Atelier Ryza* is the first game in the series I played for a considerable about of time. As of this writing, I have completed about 40% of the game... according to my PlayStation 4. Aside the frivolous controversy about Ryza's character design... being off the norm for being a little thicc, her design is still very cute. The overall artwork of the game makes you feel not overwhelming and pleasant to listen to... especially through a stereo system.

The one minor complaint I have, which is really not an issue, is the number monsters you encounter. There's some 80 monsters in the game, but most of them are a variations of slimes, weasels, fairies, golems, wyverns, sharks (yes, sharks) and knights. Most bosses I fought so far are just larger versions. There could have been a little more varieties of monsters.

One thing I'm not sure of is if there's any post-game content, though I highly suspect there is. It could be really tedious finding materials for alchemy at times, but it's fun searching for what you need. Although I haven't completed the game, I have enjoyed playing the game and having fun with it. I cannot compare this game to the previous games in the series, but I think it's a game worth playing for JRPG fans. It's a nice starter game for those getting into the JRPG genre. **Comez**
